Harmful Interference on exclusive Amateur Radio 40-m-Band by transmissions of "Radio Golos Rossiye" (Voice-of-Russia)

Dear Mr. Ambassador,

Since 1 February 2011 the Russian Radio Station "Golos Rossiye" has been transmitting programs in Russian language from 0800 – 1500 UTC on the frequency 7200,0 kHz with very high power.

The location of the transmitter is St. Petersburg.

As the range 7000 – 7200 kHz is allocated world wide to the Amateur Radio Service, these transmissions are causing very harmful interference to the Radio Amateurs world wide.

Therefore I ask you to contact the Headquarters of "Radio Golos Rossiye" to stop harmful Interference immediately. The radio Amateurs of the world have the right to use their exclusive Amateur Radio frequencies without the interference of "Radio Golos Rossiye".
