Harmful Interference on exclusive Amateur Radio 20-m-Band and 30-m Band by transmissions of Turkish Broad Casting Stations.

Dear Mr. Ambassador,

Since 1 April 2011 a Turkish Radio Station has been transmitting Programs daily in the Turkish language starting at 1848 UTC with Turkish music on the frequency 10110 kHz. A second station starting the program in the Turkish language at 17.23 UTC on the frequency 14210 KHz.

The location of the transmitters is located near Ankara.

As the range 10100 KHz – 10150 KHz and 14000 KHz-14350 KHz is allocated world wide to the Amateur Radio Service, these transmissions are causing very harmful interference to the Radio Amateurs world wide.

Therefore I ask you to contact the Headquarters of these radio stations to stop harmful Interference immediately. The radio Amateurs of the world have the right to use their exclusive Amateur Radio frequencies without the interference of such radio stations.
Thank you very much for taking action.
