NEWS FROM THE VHSC-MEMBERS:

- ON5ME, Oscar, VHSC 78, silent key.

We received the most shocking message that ON5ME, Oscar, VHSC 78, suddenly became a silent key on 6 January 2007, following a heart-failure, at the age of 65 years.

A deep feeling of confusion and disbelief went through the worldwide CW-community, as Oscar was a widely esteemed and highly dedicated personality in our world.

From 1 January 1991 – 1 January 2007 Oscar acted as EUCW-President. His enthusiastic work for the EUCW-sake did increase the amount of EUCW-memberclubs from 13 in 1991 to the present 38 EUCW-memberclubs.

In 1981 Oscar, being a great QRQ-lover, founded both the Radio Telegraphy Super High Speed Club SHSC and the Radio Telegraphy Extremely High Speed Club EHSC.

Oscar was one of the judges within the organization of the IARU Region I High Speed Telegraphy (HST) Championships, and he acted as one of the judges of the annual German Telegraphy Championships as well.

Oscar visited year after year annual CW-meetings, f.i. in Büdingen and Erbeshausen, where he always was welcomed as a respected guest.

ON5ME, Oscar, VHSC 78, became a VHSC-member on 6 January 1982, exactly 25 years before his decease. During the period 1982 – 1993, when our VHSC grew from 69 members up to 318 members, Oscar made more than 30 VHSC-sponsor-QSO's. Which means, that Oscar intensively supported the huge growth of our VHSC-membershiplist; ON5ME is a very important root of our present VHSC, as he is for the EUCW as well.

It is with very sad feelings when we now realize, that we have to continue our QRQ-efforts without the motivating and direction giving presence of ON5ME, Oscar, VHSC 78.

- More sad news: F5TFP, Jean-Pierre, VHSC 317, became a silent key on 13 June 2006. Jean-Pierre had been a VHSC-member since 1 May 1991.
- Again sad news: DJ4IY, Cas, VHSC 196, became a silent key on 17 November 2006. Cas was a VHSC-member since 28 August 1985.
- Ex-DL8BBO, Armin, VHSC 137, changed his call: he is DL3BU now.
- EA7WA, Angel, VHSC 201, is also QRV with his first call: EA7CEZ.
- DA0HSC, DK0HSC and DL0HSC are the three clubstations of the HSC.

Operator of DL0HSC is VHSC 127, Alfons, DL1TL.

DL0HSC transmits the "HSC-Bulletin" on the first Saturday of each month at 15.00 UTC on 7.025 MHz in English and at 21.00 UTC (during summertime at 20.00 UTC) on about 3.555 Mhz in German language.
