EUROPEAN CW ASSOCIATION EUCW.

In June of this year it was 30 years ago, that the first ideas to establish an EUCW were born.

The EUCW-OBJECTIVES were written down by SM5TK, SCAG #1, then.

In 1979 EUCW was founded by SCAG, AGCW-DL and G-QRP-Club.

The EUCW – OBJECTIVES say:

The main objective of EUCW is to form an association of European independent amateur radio CW clubs. Using the association as a platform they may exchange ideas, arrange contests, swap diplomas and do many other things considered as of benefit to amateur radio.

So, EUCW had its start with “only” 3 European CW-Clubs.

When looking at the present amount of member-clubs (today there are 38) it just was a good start!

HSC-CONTEST ON 2 NOVEMBER 2008!

The HSC-contests are very popular and nice to participate, try it!

Dates: last Sunday in February and first Sunday in November.

Two periods per contest: 09.00 – 11.00 UTC and 15.00 – 17.00 UTC.

QSO each station once per band **and once per period.**

Exchange: RST + HSC-Nr., not-HSC-members give RST +NM.

Points: 5 points per QSO with an HSC-member, 1 point per QSO with a not-HSC-member.

Score: sum of all QSO-points.

Classes: 1) HSC-members, max. 150 W. out, 2) not-HSC-members, max. 150 W. out, 3)

HSC-members and not-members QRP, max. 5 W. out, 4) SWL's.
